5	BY MR. MALTZ:
6	Q· Can you state your full name, please.
7	A Billie Jo Beeman.
8	Q And is Beeman spelled B-e-e-m-a-n?
9	A Yes, sir.
10	Q What is your home address, Miss Beeman?
11	A 2942 Spring Park Road, Apartment 406.
12	Q 2943?
13	A Spring Park Road.
14	Q What's your date of birth?
15	A 5/4/72.
16	Q And who do you live with at that address?
17.	A My boyfriend and my Uncle Chris.
18	Q Who is your boyfriend?
19	A Bobby Hatch.
20	Q The reason we had you come down here today is
21	about a case involving John David Hatch and Ronald Clark
22	where they're accused of killing one man here in
23	Jacksonville and another man in Nassau County, as I'm sure
24	you're aware of.

The court reporter has just sworn you in to tell 0 1 the truth, and that means just that: you need to tell the 2 truth. 3 This is an official investigation under the 4 Florida Statutes. More specifically, what that means is 5 that your failure to speak the truth regarding any material 6 matters constitutes the crime of perjury. Do you understand 7 that? 8 Yes. Α 9 If there is anything that I ask you that you don't 10 understand and you want me to rephrase it, be sure to let me 11 know and I'll be glad to do so. Okay? 12 Yes. Α 13 Are you under the influence of anything today 14 which would cause you to be unable to understand any of my 15 questions? 16 No. A 17 Do you know John David Hatch? Q 18 Yes. Α 19 How do you know John David Hatch? Q 20 He's my boyfriend's brother. Α 21 How long have you known him? 0 22 Four years. A 23 Do you know a person by the name of Ronald Clark, 24 Ronnie Clark?

1	A Yes. I've only met him twice, though.
2	Q And how do you know him?
3	A I met him through my boyfriend.
4	Q Do you know if he and John David Hatch hang out
5	together?
6	A . Yes, they have.
7	Q I had the opportunity to discuss this with you a
8	little bit before we got started, and you told me about a
9	situation back early to middle of January of 1990 where both
10	John David Hatch and Ronald Clark came over to your
11	apartment. Do you recall the incident that I'm talking
12	about?
13	A Yes.
14	Q And is that when you recall it taking place,
15	middle or the beginning of January?
16	A Yes.
17	Q About what time was it when John David Hatch and
18	Ronald Clark came over?
19	A It was about 9:30.
20	Q What were they driving when they came over?
21	A A black truck.
22	Q Pickup truck?
23	A Yes.
24	Q Let me show you a photograph and ask you if that's
25	the pickup truck that you saw.

1	A Yes, that's the one.
2	Q For the record and correct me if I'm wrong
3	it's a black pickup truck with a white utility box in the
4	back with some side rails and a stripe going along it. And
5	it's a Dodge pickup truck, Dodge Ram pickup?
6	A Yes.
7	Q Is that the truck you saw them driving in?
8	A Yes.
9	Q Who was driving the truck when they came up and
10	who was the passenger?
11	A David was driving and Ronnie was a passenger.
12	Q Is "David" John David Hatch?
13	A Yes.
14	Q Tell me what happened when they came up, what they
15	did and what transpired.
16	A They came over to see my aunt and her boyfriend
17	Chris. David came over to talk to her and get some stuff
18	settled between them that happened before.
19	And Ronnie, Ronnie had already been drinking. And
20	he said something to David. Because they wanted to get out
21	of the apartments.
22	And Chris and my aunt went downstairs and followed
23	them around to the truck. And Ronnie got in the truck, but
24	he he was stumbling while he got in the truck. And David
25	started the truck up and they went around by where to the

1 apartments, in the front of the apartments where I live. 2 And my aunt and Chris followed them around there. And David and my aunt were talking and Ronnie was sitting 3 there making hostile words to everybody, threatening to 4 5 shoot them. And DavidYou said something about Ronnie making hostile 6 words towards people and threatening to shoot them. Did he 7 threaten to shoot them with any gun, or did he just say he 8 was going to shoot them? 9 A He threatened to shoot them with the gun he had 10 11 between his legs. 12 Q Did you actually see him reach down and pick up a 13 qun? 14 Yeah. He reached between his legs, and I saw 15 something come up and I bigured it was a gun. And he had 16 pointed it out the window in front of David. And I told 17 Ronnie to put the gun down because we didn't need any 18 shooting in the apartments. And he threatened to shoot 19 Chris with it. Q Let me show you another picture of a gun. Is this 20 21 the gun that you saw? Does it appear to be the gun that you 22 saw? 23 Yes, that's the one that he picked up. 24 Q For the record, it's a photograph of a 380

1 or silver in color. 2 Right. 3 When Ronnie and David came over, did either Ronnie or David indicate whose truck it was that they were in? 4 5 Α All Ronnie said was that he borrowed it from a friend. 6 7 Q What happened after Ronnie had picked up this gun 8 and threatened to shoot some people with it? 9 I looked -- I told Ronnie to put it down, because A 10 we didn't need any shooting. Because it's bad enough where we live now. And I asked David to ask him to put the gun 11 12 down. And Ronnie wouldn't listen. 13 And then he went to click the part back, and I 14 told Ronnie to put the gun down because, you know, there's 15 little kids around here. And then that's when he clicked it 16 back and put it back between his legs. 17 And then I told David that they just needed to 18 leave, because we don't need any trouble around here. 19 Q Did Ronnie and David eventually leave? Yeah, they left as soon as his brother pulled up. 20 21 Q Do you remember what day of the week this was? 22 It was a Friday night. A 23 Do you remember what time it was on Friday night? Q 24 I understand that it would be an approximatation on your 25 behalf, but approximately what time was it on Friday night

1	that Ronnie and David were over there in the truck?
2	A It was about 9:30.
3	Q Is that when they first arrived?
4	A Yes.
5	Q About what time was it when they left?
6	A ·It was about 11:30, because my boyfriend gets off
7	at 11. He usually don't get home till 11:30.
8	Q You talked about Ronnie staggering. Did Ronnie
9	appear to you as if he had been drinking?
10	A Yes.
11	Q Did he appear impaired to you from alcohol or some
12	other substance?
13	A I knew he was drinking, but he probably had smoked
14	some pot or something, too.
15	Q Despite him being under the influence of some type
16	of controlled substances, did he appear as if he knew what
17	was going on around him? For instance, when people were
18	talking to him, he was able to understand what they were
19	saying and when people were up near him, he knew there were
20	people near him and was able to recognize the people?
21	A Yeah.
22	Q So he did appear to know what was going on around

9	there.

14	A I've talked to David one time on the phone. And
15	that was just to call about his kids.
16	Q Did he discuss the case at all?

18	Q Is everything I've asked you to your
19	understanding; do you understand everything I asked you?
20	A Yes.
